Our latest initiative to grow Youth Leadership capacity in the diocese began in January with a first group of participants. This, we hope, will run each year, as we seek to grow the local capacity in partnerships to accompany young people on their unique journey of faith and equip a new generations of leaders.

Our office has also produced a prayer resource for the year where the theme is Pilgrims of Hope. The New Year brings the opportunity to reflect on parish life, mission and ministries.


Guided by the *Building Hope Strategic Planning Resource for 2025 - 2027*, a

As well as training for Funeral Ministry Teams in parishes, formation is also available for those who will take on the leadership roles in times of prayer with families before a funeral, planning and leading Funeral Services that aren't Mass, and leading the prayers at the graveside or crematorium.

Those who have completed the Funeral Teams training are encouraged to consider taking this next step and training for this leadership role.

The next training is taking place on 3rd, 10th and 24th March in St Paul's.


This resource is so accessible and easy to use, it will really make a difference to our preparation.



### **#YML:** Diocesan Certificate in Youth Ministry Leadership



Over 30 people from parishes across the Diocese took part in the first module of the Diocesan Certificate in Youth Ministry Leadership on January 11th in St Paul's Arran Quay. This practical course is designed to build capacity for Youth Ministry throughout the Diocese at a local parish and partnership level. Kevin Mullaly set the scene in the morning with a session on Youth Culture Today, providing valuable insights into the landscape that shapes all the course and participants hope to achieve in the coming

months and beyond. After lunch, participants explored the core text of Christus Vivit and how to explore their local setting with a Pastoral Reflection. The day concluded with Fr Kieran O'Mahony celebrating a lectio style Mass. It was a jam-packed day filled with energy, acknowledgement of the challenges, but a deep desire and call to act! The course continues February 22nd.
