We are also offering workshops to use the new resource for accompanying parents when they present their child for the sacraments of reconciliation and holy communion for the first time. This resource is called Grow In Faith, it aims to enable parishes to enable parents to be the first educators in the ways of faith and links intentionally with Grow In Love. The first two workshops for deaneries will take place in October. This is for sacramental teams.

We continue to offer support for all areas of ministry, Peter Siney is available to partnerships and deaneries for training, with a jam packed diary already, this includes PPC training, eucharistic ministers and readers training as well as funeral ministry training. He takes on the role of Course Coordinator for the Pathways course, and we have a full complement of first years.

Fr Pat continues to work with the Laudate and Emmanuel Projects, and is available to support all liturgical music initiatives as well as continuing funeral ministry training.



# Adult Faith Ministry

**RENEWING** YOUR PARISH MINISTRIES Parishes are being introduced to the BUILDING HOPE PASTORAL STRATEGIC PLANNING RESOURCE which will help to shape the growth of parishes and parish partnerships over the next 3 years.

Here are some ideas of how we might do this by renewing our parish ministries...



In your Newsletter use some of the quotes (e.g. from Pope Francis) from *Voluntary Ministry Matters*  Before we start tapping people on the shoulder asking them to volunteer, we might first think about growing people's understanding that parish ministry is part of our responsibility as members of the parish, that all are needed and have a role to play. This could form part of homilies and reflections at Masses as well as being a message in your newsletter, website and social media.

Take some time to review the ministries in the parish... Which are working well? How might they be even better? What areas of ministry need some attention and support? What ministry groups are missing? Do all your ministries have a Team approach?

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Use the 'Being a Ministry Friendly Parish' survey on P11 Voluntary Ministry Matters to help you find areas that need to grow

Have a conversation with the other parishes in your partnership or Deanery to arrange training for parish ministry groups Don't feel you have to do everything on your own. Perhaps there are resources, ideas for best practice and recruitment that can be shared between parishes?

Running over 6 Saturdays, the aim of this Diocesan Certificate is to build up the capacity of Youth Ministry and Youth Ministry Leadership throughout the Archdiocese of Dublin. It is a highly practical course where participants are given new experiences & key resources, including gaining vital skills to put into practice in their local context, while also being grounded in key church documents such as Christus Vivit. It was a busy summer as your Young Adult group headed out on the Camino starting in Sarria and walking the 115km to reach Santiago. Over 5 days, hills, rain and blisters featured, but it was a glorious day when we finally descended on Santiago. We headed to the pilgrim Mass that evening and to our delight, the famous Botafumero swung, marking the end of a fantastic day. Before flying home, the group headed to the seaside town of



Finisterre where the famous lighthouse is located and where St James thought he had reached the end of the world. One final group dinner in Santiago brought our time on the Camino trail to an end, but it was only the beginning of the journey of faith together. At the end of September the group is meeting again to check-in on what has happened since and share some tapas together. Thanks to Fr Brendan (chaplain UCD) who also accompanied the group and provided some great songs!

- For those looking to develop a Youth Ministry in their parish


